



## **Disclaimers**


I'm just a hobbyist! There could be discrepencies in the illustrations. Images are NOT to scale.


Proceed with caution when interacting with any insect you are not sure about!

I have omitted the order of insects that include flies, wasps, bees, and ants. Maybe they'll get included in issue #2!


I've mainly focused on arthropods found in the Tom Graham Learning Garden.







Even though I'm called a lady'bug', I'm actually a beetle!




Ladybug larvae
